## **Dearly beloved Family, Partners & Friends!**

### Here is our MISSIONARY REPORT of JUNE to AUGUST 2018

This time our work assignments started from the City of Chiriacu, in the department of Amazonas (border with Ecuador) in the northeast of Peru.

Pastor Walter, Linda (Chachi), Letty and I taught the Word of God in the primary school of Chiriacu with 120 children. We also reached two Native Awajún communities: PaKun and Alto Pacuy. In Pakun, which is the closest village to where we live, are 126 children and in Alto Pacuy 85 youths in high school. In order to reach the village of Alto Pacuy we leave our house at 6 am. After a 15 min walk, we reach the river, where we wait for a boat. There is no timetable. The boat trip takes 20 minutes. We hop on land and after another 25-minute walk up a very steep hill, we reach the school. We make these trips every day despite some difficulties such as weather or long periods of waiting for a boat to take us back home.

We thank God that we have the full support of the directors and teachers to take advantage of the lack of teachers for the subject Religion in these schools. All Peruvian public schools have this subject in their curriculum; however no teaching materials have been shipped from the Catholic Church which issues them. We have never seen Priest or teachers go to the First nations communities. We supply New Testaments for all

students. But for lack of funding there is a chronic shortage of teachers and pastors serving the Indigenous Native people. So our incursion there has been on time and very much of a blessing for the teachers and the students themselves.

In October Letty Berrocal will start with a commitment to teach all teachers of the elementary school in Alto Pacuy, because they see the need to learn God's Word, and get to know Him, thus they will also be able to teach their students. What grace God is making available to us that we, KHM and Ajamat Org are sent to the First Nations people in the jungles to share God's Word and demonstrate His love and power.

You need to know: 10 years ago the destiny of most children was to get married and to have children at the age of 14 or 15 instead of finishing school. Praise God, now we are seeing radical changes in their behavior because of the teaching of the Word of God and motivational chats given by prophetic teacher Letty. She encourages young people to dream of a professional future and not getting stuck marrying as soon as they finish school. We are very grateful to God to see that there is an awakening in this generation and their parents.

A clear example for them is Shina, an indigenous native girl we have had living with us for more than 9 years (parenting and educating). Shina is now the director and teacher of a public school in a community called La Reserva. Shina receives a salary of 2000 soles [\$605]. This salary allows her to study at the university on Saturdays and Sundays and thus conclude her career in Accounting and Taxation.

We thank all of you, our coworkers in God's vineyard, for your prayers and generous giving. Together we are expanding God's glorious Kingdom in these areas forgotten by the government and the Church.
